



Who is considered a group?

We welcome families, businesses, clubs, and travel groups to schedule a docent led tour. If you are a school group we have a separate request process for education tours.

When are group tours available?

Tours are available during the Museum's regular hours and as tour guides are available. All group tours are led by a docent from the Museum. Please schedule at least two weeks in advance of your visit.

How long are group tours?

We generally recommend a 1-hour visit, though the length of your stay can vary with the size and interests of your group. Let us know if you'd like your group to have time to explore on their own or visit the Gift Gallery. Please plan to have your group arrive 10 minutes before your tour is scheduled to begin and have your group representative check in at the front desk.

What is the cost for group tours?

Groups of less than 10 are charged the regular per person admission price. Scheduled groups with 10 or more adult participants receive a \$1 discount per person. For groups of 10 or more the tour operator and bus driver receive complimentary admission to the Museum. For an additional fee, a hands-on creative art activity that corresponds with our exhibits can be designed specifically for your group as part of your tour.

Where can I park?

The Museum's parking lot is located south of the building and is reachable from Second Avenue East. There is also off-street parking near the building and a drop-off area near the main entrance on the corner of Second Avenue East and Third Street East. There is a designated handicap parking space in the parking lot, our handicap accessible entrance is off the alley on the west side of the building.

Can we eat there?

During nice weather, you are welcome to use the picnic tables located outside of the Museum. Several restaurants and cafes are located within walking distance of the Museum.
