____ **Meet the Museum**, Pre-school -1st Grade *Length of tour: 30 minutes (optional 30 minute art activity may be added)*
In this introduction to the museum children learn art media (painting, sculpture, photography), art themes (still life, landscape, portrait), and museum terms (gallery, artist, docent). They will practice good museum manners while exploring the galleries and other spaces in our historic Carnegie building.

____ **Color, Line, and Shape**, Grades 1-12 *Length of tour: 45 minutes (optional 45 minute art activity may be added)*
Investigate how color, line, and shape are used to make works of art. Through guided looking and discussion students understand how artists consciously manipulate the elements of art: color, line, shape, form, space, texture, and space—often in combination—to achieve specific results.

____ **Art & Artists of Montana**, Grades 2-12 *Length of tour: 45-60 minutes (optional 45 minute art activity may be added)*
Explore the history, landscape, animals, and cultural influences of Montana through art. Featured are historic and contemporary sculptures, paintings, and photographs; when on display memorabilia used to promote Glacier National Park and Montana tourism are included. Artists represented depend upon current exhibits.

____ **Current Exhibition Tour**, All Grades *Length of tour: 30-45 minutes (optional art activity may be added)*
The focus of this tour is on highlights of an exhibition temporarily on display. It can be adapted to meet your group's special interests. Check our website at glacierartmuseum.org for exhibition information.
